### **Health and Safety of Campers**

### **If your camper has special dietary restrictions...**

If you have any campers or counselors on a special diet for medical reasons, Camp Tadmor would be happy to send you a copy of the menu for your child's week (available one week prior to your session). Any supplemental foods needed may be brought to camp and stored at their food allergy station, which includes a prep counter, refrigerator and microwave. - Laundry bag

- Large plastic trash bag (for wet items on last day)
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, toothbrush/toothpaste)
- Towels
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Bible
- Pencils/pens
- Stationary, stamps, envelopes
- Insect repellent
- \$35-\$100 (for hat, crafts, paintball, snack bar, and other camp store purchases)
- Camera (not on a phone, iPod, or iPad)

## Do Not Bring:

- Cell Phone (We are a cell phone-free camp. Our counselors don't have theirs either)
- Music devices

- Weapons (guns, knives, etc.)

- Two-piece swimsuits (girls)

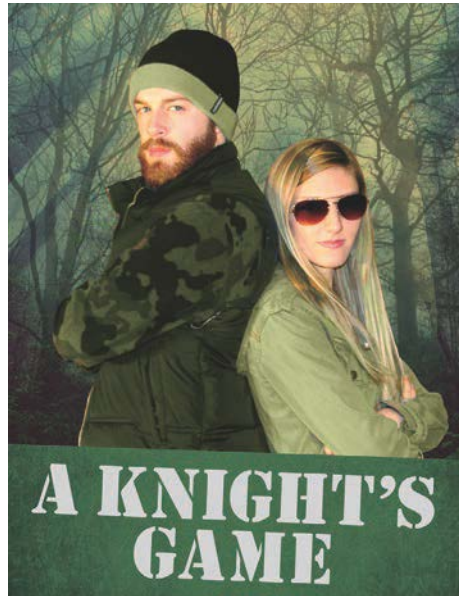

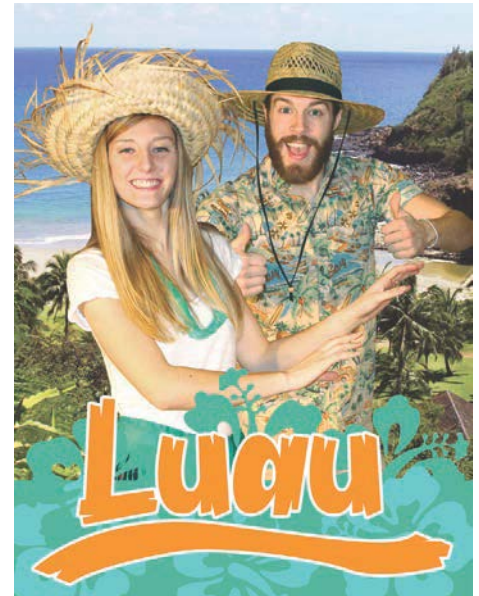
## Medieval Festival

(no weapons please)



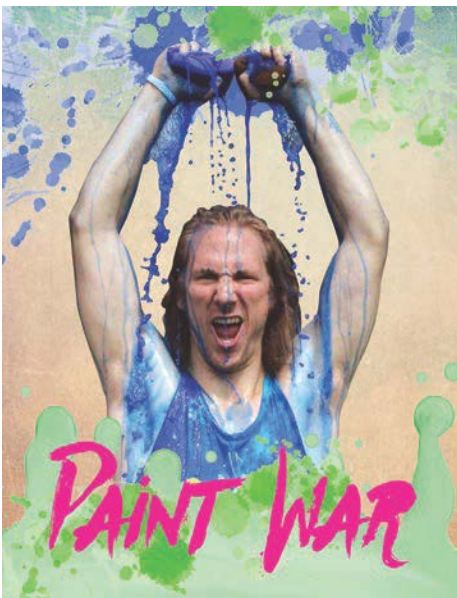
## A Knight's Game

Bring that camo to sneak through the woods in stealth mode.



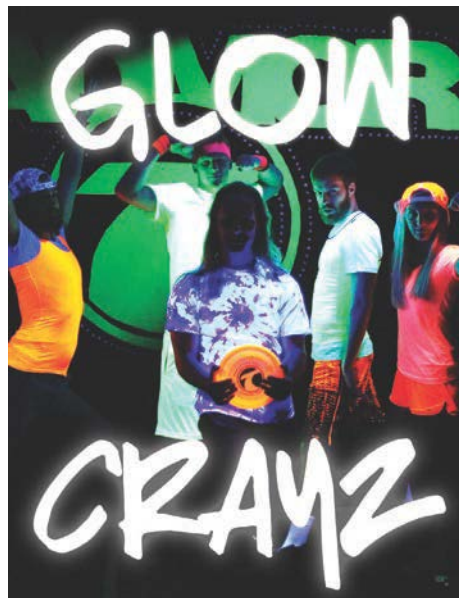
## Luau

Get down Hawaiian style with some grass skirts and tacky shirts. (no coconut bras)



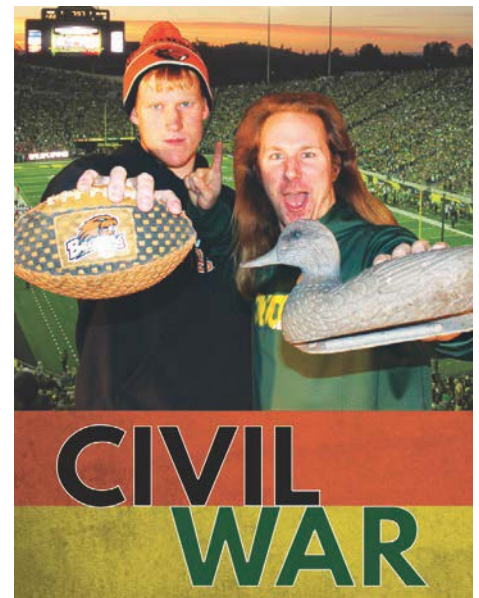
## Paint War
